- Perpetrators were intimate companions (50%), accompanied by pals (30%) and strangers (20%).

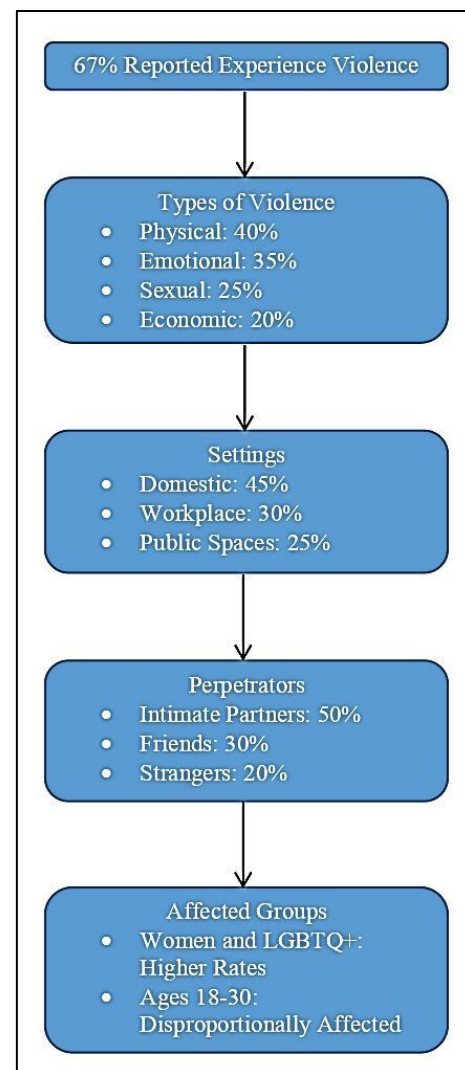


Figure 1: Flowchart summarizing key findings from the present study on gender- and sexuality-related violence.
